Report: 5 YEAR PLAN CLGA EVENTS

We ran into a bump in the road of our 2024 plans – one of our clubs that had committed to hosting had to withdraw and reschedule to 2025. The result has been a bit of a scramble to fill out CLGA Closed Amateur host site for 2024. That being said we have reached out to one of our Member Clubs and we are hopeful they can book us in.

The world of golf is in constant evolution! The wonderful clubs that make up the CLGA are working hard for their membership and their budgets. With that I would like to explain a few differences between a CLGA event vs a Corporate event.

- 1. CORPORATE vs CLOSED Events: our events are CLOSED to female players who are members of a CLGA Member Club. Corporate events are OPEN to anyone who would like to play and fits the criteria for that event.
- 2. MEMBERSHIP of CLGA has its privileges as hosting events is shared amongst all the clubs in the CLGA. It then in turn becomes a big "interclub" or "member event". When you pay your dues to your club you do not have to pay green fees every time you play this is how we keep costs down in our events as a sort of reciprocal.
 - a. An ALBERTA GOLF LADIES OPEN event costs players \$285.00 for a 3 day event where the CLGA Ladies Closed AM was \$190.00 for 3 days. All Tournament entry fees paid by a player goes back to the host club in the form of F&B and prizes (pro shop gift certificates)
 - b. The CLGA does contribute to the host clubs of our major events a one time fee per player who signs up to help add revenue to the host club. This value is under review for the upcoming seasons
- 3. We recognize that our Member clubs want to make sure they are getting something for hosting and CLGA is lucky to get recognition from Local Media with highlights on CTV news, Media blasts through Social Media, and CLGA Newsletters to our members and partners.

We would like to hear from you as players, hosts, Head Pros, and GMs on how we can bring more value to your club when hosting? Do you feel you get value from your entry fee? Understand that an increase of entry fee goes directly to the host club and NOT the CLGA.
