

RULES

Golf Canada rules govern play except as modified by Local Rules.

LOCAL RULES

Immovable obstructions close to putting green: In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, when a ball lies in the general area and in an area cut to fairway height or less, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is: on the player's line of play, is within two club-lengths of the putting green, and is within two club-lengths of the ball. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b by dropping the original ball or another ball in a relief area that is: no closer to the hole, in the general area, and provides complete relief from the immovable obstruction. (Exception – There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.)

All yardages are measured to the centre of the green.

All flower beds and rock gardens are ground under repair. Relief must be taken.

Relief is permitted from all wooden paths through bunkers. Take the nearest point of relief and drop within one club length. The ball must be dropped in the bunker.

LIGHTNING POLICY

Players will be warned of lightning within 5 miles (8 km) of the property by the Thor Guard prediction/detection system which sounds like a police siren blast signalling suspension of play. All players must leave their respective holes and either return to the Clubhouse or go to an on-course lightning protection shelter including food and beverage outlets, washrooms, outbuildings, and rain shelters. Players who continue to play will be doing so at their own risk. The Glencoe Golf and Country Club accepts no liability for any member or guest who fails to suspend play after the warning siren sounds. Furthermore, players who continue to play are out of order. Players returning to the course after all clear siren, have the right to return to the position they had when play was suspended. Three short blasts of the horns over 5 seconds will indicate it is safe to resume your position on the golf course or outdoor activity. Violation of this Policy may lead to suspension of membership privileges. See website for full policy.
