THE YEAR AHEAD IN GOLF: 2022 SEASON CALENDAR HIGHLIGHTS

Rileys Best Ball Ladies Classic The 2022 season kicks off in March with early registration in the longest running best ball tournament in North America, the 37th **Riley's Best Ball Ladies Classic™**. The lowest combined indexes of two-member teams from the same club constitute 48 teams that are separated into a championship, first and second flight competition. All teams are guaranteed two games in a double knock out series. A and B side finals in each flight are played and celebrated on Championship Sunday in June hosted at Canyon Meadows.

CHAMPS Players that are interested in meeting like-minded golfers who prefer a moderate level of competition sprinkled with a heavy dose of camaraderie may find the **City Hospitality and Match Play Section (CHAMPS)** most appealing.

The CHAMPS league is an interclub team match play event that is a round-robin schedule of games between participating clubs. The event features two A players and two B players from each club competing against four players from another club with similar playing abilities. Following golf, the focus turns to fun where players share their experience of the day over lunch. Friendships formed, good golf and 'rather forget' incidents are shared in a wind up tournament hosted at a different club each year in September.

Medalist Series The **Medalist** is a series of 6 one-day tournaments that brings together seasoned competitors who relish both personal challenge and team competition and spirit. Eligibility requires competitors to carry a handicap factor of 12 or less. Each tournament has a 24-player field divided in to 6 teams of four players competing against each other in a 2 best net format. At season end, individual performances are recognized and rewarded after cumulative statistics for most fairways, greens in regulation and up and downs are tallied. The highest honors are bestowed to the players with lowest scoring averages for the series.

Calgary Ladies Closed City Amateur The **City Ladies Amateur** is considered to be the marquee tournament of the CLGA season and is open to any member who carries an official handicap index. The competition is a flighted, 54-hole, 3-day, sanctioned stroke play event. The field is comprised of 96 women and juniors assigned to approximately 8 flights. The City Ladies Amateur and Runner up champion and crowned based on lowest total 3-day gross scores.



Calgary Ladies Closed Senior Amateur The **City Senior Ladies Amateur** is a flighted 36 hole, 2-day, sanctioned stroke play event. It is open to senior ladies over the age of 50. Awards are based on two aged groups; City Senior Amateur 50-64 and City Super Senior Amateur 65+. Both champions are crowned based on their 2-day cumulative gross scores. The field is comprised of 96 members who carry an official handicap factor.

Calgary Junior Girls Open Amateur The **City Junior Girls Amateur** is a flighted, 2-day, stroke play event open to both CLGA members and non-members 18 years of age and under. This year, the event is being featured on the Maple Leaf Tour in Carstairs. **The Development Camp and 9-hole tournament** for *new to the game* junior golfers is being held at Golfuture YYC - no handicap required.

The **Tournament of Champions** brings together CLGA member club champions from private and public clubs with an exclusive invitation to one final head-to-head competition. The 18-hole event rewards both a gross and net “champion of the club champions”.
