

CLGA Ladies Closed Amateur - Player Information

1. Score Card Information

Players will tee off from the CLGA Tee markers (Raven Green tees on course scorecard) with a course rating of 72.5; slope rating of 139; total yards of 5761. Scorecards are to be exchanged at the first tee within your group for scoring purposes. ***Please proceed directly to the scoring table upstairs after your round.***

2. Registration

Registration will start at 6:30 AM on Monday June 24. Please arrive at the registration table at least 30 minutes in advance of your tee time.

3. Tournament Details

- Tee times will commence at 8:00 a.m. on hole #1 and hole #10. Players must arrive at their respective tee box 10 minutes prior to their tee time.
- Play will be from the CLGA Tee Markers.
- Flights will be determined by factors. Factors/handicaps will be frozen after registration closes on June 10th.

4. Notes to Competitors

- Target pace of play is 4 hours 30 minutes. Pace of play will be monitored and repeat violations subject to a 2 stroke penalty. One player from each group will be given a Tagmarshal to attach to their bag/cart which monitors time played. Please drop the Tagmarshal in the boxes at end of Hole 9 and Hole 18 upon completing your round.
- Pull carts are complementary and power carts are available at \$21 per seat; limit 2 carts per group.
- The driving range will open at 6:00 a.m. each morning.
- Participant score cards and pin placement sheets will be available each day at the starting tee boxes.
- Cell phones must be put on silent or vibrate. Refrain from using cell phones except in an emergency or to contact the Priddis rules official representative, Diane White at 403-281-9826. Immediately following your round proceed directly to the scoring tables just outside the Presidents room upstairs in the clubhouse.

5. Tee Time Postings

Tee times for the first round June 24th and the second round June 25th will be posted on the CLGA Website at www.calgaryladiesgolf.ca after completion of the draw. Tee times for the final round on June 26th will be posted on the CLGA Website after completion of play on June 25th or you may call the Pro Shop (403-931-3316) after 6:00 p.m.

6. Caddies

Caddies, whether present for all 3 days, or just one of the three days, must be registered on the first day of competition at the registration table. Caddie bibs are to be signed out by the competitor at the registration table. Please be sure to return caddy bibs to the scoring table and confirm their name is checked off as being returned.

Competitors will be charged for bibs not returned. Caddies will be required to wear running shoes on the golf course, no golf shoes allowed.

Caddies may purchase snacks and lunches at the half-way house or in the clubhouse. Banquet tickets for caddies may be purchased at the registration table on the first day of competition. Priddis will accept Debit, Credit or charge to your home club account.

7. Hospitality and Meals

Water stations are available on the course at Holes 5, 8, 10 (halfway house), 12 and 15. Please bring your refillable water bottle. Snacks are available for purchase at the halfway house. You are welcome to bring your own snacks to the course.

Complimentary lunch in the clubhouse will be available for all competitors after completion of rounds on Monday and Tuesday. A banquet dinner will be served on Wednesday in the Banquet room after completion of play. Tickets will be handed out at the registration table. Please bring your tickets for these meals with you to the dining room.

8. Safety on the Course

If a weather issue requires a suspension in play, **one prolonged horn** will sound. Players must proceed to the on-course shelters immediately. If play is suspended, a shared shelter can be accessed at the end of holes #1, #5, and #8 on the front nine, and another shared shelter can be accessed from the tee on hole #13 and #17. There is also a shelter between the 15th green and 16th tee box. Refer to the CLGA Rules document for further information.

9. Spectators

Walking spectators are welcome and requested to stay off the fairways and greens and remain at least 30 feet from all competitors. Spectators are expected to be quiet during play. No carts for spectators will be allowed on the course.

10. Spotters

Spotters dressed in white tops and black/blue bottoms will be located throughout the course to assist you with errant shots.

Spotters signals will be as per below based on your ball location:

- “Your ball appears to be safe and / or I can see your ball” - both arms crossing back and forth at waist height.
- “Your ball has entered the out of bounds area” - both arms extended up in air.
- “Your ball has entered a trouble area and / or I am unsure of your ball location” - both arms extended to errant shot area.
- “Your ball has entered a penalty area” - both arms crossed at chest.

Please review and proceed according to the Rules of Golf.

11. Tournament Awards

Overall winners:

- ❖ **Champion, First Overall Low Gross** - \$300 gift certificate
- ❖ **2nd Overall Low Gross** - \$200 gift certificate
- ❖ **Overall Low Net** - \$150 gift certificate

Flight winners:

- ❖ **First Low Gross** - \$125 gift certificate
- ❖ **Second Low Gross** - \$100 gift certificate
- ❖ **First Low Net** - \$75 gift certificate
- ❖ **Second Low Net** - \$50 gift certificate.

12. Breaking Ties

In the event of a tie for the Calgary Ladies Amateur Champion a sudden death playoff will take place beginning on hole #18 playing it a maximum of 3 times to determine a winner. If still tied, players will move to hole #1 to determine a winner. All other flight ties will be broken using the Scorecard Matching Retrogression Method.

13. Close of Competition

The competition is deemed to have been closed when the trophy has been presented to the winner, or in the absence of a prize ceremony, when the Committee has approved all scores.

14. Awards Banquet

The Awards Banquet will be held Wednesday in the Dining room following the completion of play of the final group. Your attendance at the banquet will need to be confirmed on the first day of registration. Extra banquet tickets for caddies and guests may be purchased at the registration table on this first day of registration. The cost will be \$50 per guest and Priddis will accept Debit, Credit or charge to your home club account.
