

# CLGA SENIOR AMATEUR 2022 - PLAYER INFORMATION

## 1. Score Card Information

Players will tee off from the Red Tees with a course rating of Par 72; slope rating of 129 (using Red Short tee box on hole #8); total yards of 5062. See scorecard online at [www.hamptonsgolfclub.com/course/scorecard](http://www.hamptonsgolfclub.com/course/scorecard).

### 1.a Local Rules and Regulations

- **OUT OF BOUNDS:** Defined by white stakes and perimeter fences. There is no relief from boundary fences.
- **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:** Flower beds, rock walls (i.e. behind the green on #16), yardage plates, 150-yard markers, sprinkler heads, cart paths, stairways, and control boxes are considered immovable obstructions if they interfere with your stance or swing. Proceed under Rule 16 – Free relief for swing and stance: drop within relief area no nearer the hole.
- **DROP ZONES:** A designated drop zone on hole #9 may be used as an option if your ball ends up in the penalty area on the left side of green; one stroke penalty. There is a drop zone on holes #17 & #18 for balls that end up on maintenance road. Free relief.
- **PENALTY AREAS:** Defined by red stakes or lines. In the absence of, they are defined by the break of the ground into the rocks, water, or the curb (#14). Proceed under Rule 17.
- **TARGET PACE OF PLAY is 4 hours and 10 minutes.** Pace of player assistance will be out on the course to help maintain the pace. If identified as a slow competitor, you may be subject to penalty as set out in the Tournament Rules Document. Please do your part to make it a great day for all competitors by keeping up to the group in front of you. A group is deemed to be out of position if at least one member of the group is not on the tee box before the group in front puts the flag in for that same hole.
- **NO GIMMIES.** All balls must be holed out.
- **If a situation arises and you are in doubt about the correct procedure, you may play two balls under Rule 20.1.** It is critical that the competitor should FIRST announce to a fellow competitor their intention to proceed under this rule and further announce which ball they wish to count if the rules permit the procedure used for that ball. Before returning your scorecard, the competitor must report all facts of the situation to the Tournament Official(s). Failure to report all facts of the situation will result in disqualification.
- Washrooms are located at the end of hole #6, #9 and #14.

## 2. Registration

Registration will start at **7AM on Tuesday, August 9**. Please arrive at the registration table at least 30 minutes in advance of your tee time.

## 3. Tournament Details

- Tee times will commence at 8:00 a.m. on hole #1 and hole #11. Players must arrive at their respective tee box 10 minutes prior to their tee time.
- Play will be from the CLGA Tee Markers (Hampton's red tee boxes).
- Flights will be determined by indexes. Indexes/handicaps were frozen at midnight on July 31, 2022.

## 4. Notes to Competitors

- Pull carts are complementary and power carts are available at \$25 per person; limit 2 carts per group. These are purchased in the Pro Shop.
- Power carts are allowed on fairways (90° rule; weather dependent) on HOLES 2, 3, 4, 6, 10, 11, 13, 16, 17 & 18 ONLY. Carts must stay on path for HOLES 1, 5, 7, 8, 9, 12, 14 & 15. Carts should not be driven within 30 yards of greens or tee boxes, on steep hills or in any fescue grass areas.
- On Hole #6, please watch for the on/off buttons for a flashing red light located to the right of the white tee box which identifies it is unsafe to proceed to hit off of a tee box until players are clear of the fairway. The "on" button is located just below the red tee box on the right-hand side of the cart path. The "off" button is located to the right of the cart path at the turn towards the green.
- Overnight club storage will NOT be available.
- The driving range will open at 7:00 a.m. each morning.
- Participant score cards, pin placement information, and caddy bibs will be available at the registration desk at sign-in.
- Cell phones must be put on silent or vibrate. Refrain from using cell phones except in an emergency or to call for a Rules Official.
- Rules officials will be available on the course both days.
- Immediately following your round proceed directly to the scoring tables in the main Lobby. Your scorecards will be vetted and will require sign-off by the participant at that time.

## 5. Tee Time Postings

Tee times for the first round on Tuesday, August 9 will be posted on the CLGA Website at [www.calgaryladiesgolf.ca](http://www.calgaryladiesgolf.ca) after completion of the draw on **Tuesday, August 9** Tee times for the final round on Wednesday, August 10 will be posted on the CLGA Website after completion of play on Tuesday, August 9.

## 6. Caddies

Caddies, whether present for both days or just one of the days, must be registered on the first day of competition at the registration table. Caddy bibs can be signed out at that time by the competitor. Please be sure to return caddy bibs to the scoring table and confirm their name is checked off as being returned. Competitors will be charged for bibs not returned. Caddies will be required to wear running shoes on the golf course, no golf shoes allowed.

Caddies may purchase snacks and lunches at the half-way house or in the clubhouse. After registering, lunch tickets for caddies may be purchased for \$22/pp (Tuesday) and/or \$50/pp (Wednesday) at the Pro Shop on the first day of competition and must be paid for before a caddy bib is signed out.

### **7. Hospitality and Meals**

Complimentary lunch will be available for all competitors after completion of rounds on Tuesday. Refreshments and snacks are available for purchase at the Pavilion next to the putting green. You are encouraged to bring a reusable water bottle as filtered water is available in the ladies' locker room and each ladies washroom on the course. A buffet lunch will be served on Wednesday in the Banquet room following the completion of play. Trophies and awards will be presented after all groups are finished their rounds.

### **8. Safety on the Course**

If a weather issue requires a suspension in play, shelters are located at the washrooms located after holes #9 and #14 and at the Pro Shop. Refer to the Rules document for further information.

### **9. Spectators**

Spectators are requested to stay off of the fairways and greens at all times and will remain at least 30 feet from all competitors. Spectators are expected to be quiet during play.

### **10. Spotters**

There are no Spotters on the course. Proceed accordingly under the Rules of Golf.

### **11. Tournament Awards**

### **12. Breaking Ties**

In the event of a tie for the Calgary Senior Ladies Amateur Champion, a sudden death playoff will take place beginning on hole #18 playing it a maximum of 3 times to determine a winner. If still tied, players will move to hole #1 to determine a winner. All other flight ties will be broken using the USGA Scorecard Retrogression Method from last 9,6,3,1 holes.

### **13. Close of Competition**

The competition is deemed to have been closed when the trophy has been presented to the winner, or in the absence of a prize ceremony, when the Committee has approved all scores.

### **14. Awards Banquet**

The Awards Banquet will be held Wednesday in the Banquet room following the completion of play. Trophies and awards will be presented after all groups are finished their rounds. Your attendance at the banquet will need to be confirmed on the first day of registration. Extra banquet tickets for caddies and guests may be purchased at the Pro Shop on the first day of registration. Cost will be \$50.
